

How to Sponsor

You can sponsor a child for Rs. 5000/- a year.

The money will be utilised to cover the expenses incurred on a child's educational requirements. Apart from individual child sponsorship you can make a general donation towards the sponsorship fund for the underprivileged/destitute children.

The children's academic performance is monitored through periodic reports received through the State/Union Territory Councils.

You will receive the child's photograph and background and reports of the child's academic performance annually.

An opportunity is given to the sponsor to interact with the sponsored child through letters, cards, gifts and visits.
