Guidelines for the State Councils for conducting ICCW Painting Competition

The ICCW Painting Competition scheme was started by ICCW in 1981 with the dual objective of creating aesthetic sense and heighten consciousness about harmony and beauty among children.

Open to school students in the age group of 5-18 years.

RULES

1. There are four groups as specified below :

GREEN GROUP : (Age 5-9 Years)

WHITE GROUP : (Age 10-16 Years)

SPECIAL GROUP : For differently abled children (See Rule 19)

YELLOW GROUP : (Age 5-10 Years)

RED GROUP : (Age 11-18 Years)

There will be three following sub-groups in each Yellow and Red Group:

- a. Intellectual Disability
- b. Visually impaired
- c. Speech / Hearing impaired

Further, specific disability and date of birth of the winners should be indicated on the reverse of the paintings for the above Yellow & Red Sub-Groups.

- 2. The Theme of the Painting Competition will be provided by ICCW.
- 3. The Painting Competition shall be : "ON THE SPOT COMPETITION".
- 4. The medium of Painting shall be Pastel, Crayon, Water Colour or Oil Colour.
- 5. The size of the Painting must be 40 CM X 50 CM (16" X 20") for all the groups.
- 6. List of participants along with the paintings should be sent to ICCW clearly mentioning the following information in English/Hindi at the back of the Paintings:

11. Disability Certificate must be enclosed wherever required. : _____

7. Time for Painting allowed is two (2) hours only.
8. Competitors must bring all necessary drawing materials. The drawing paper will be supplied by the organiser.
9. Age will be calculated from the date of 'Sit & Draw' Competition organized by the concerned State/UT Council.
10. **Participants who have secured First/Second/Third position in a particular group at ICCW Painting Competition in earlier years will not be considered in subsequent years in the same group.**
11. The decision of the Judges will be final. No correspondence, whatsoever shall be entertained.
12. All Paintings submitted for competition shall become the property of the 'INDIAN COUNCIL FOR CHILD WELFARE'.
13. Entries received after the last date as indicated below may not be included for consideration for prizes :

Last date for sending maximum 5 Paintings in each normal group adjudged best at the State/UT level in each group totalling maximum **10** paintings and 5 Paintings in each sub-group adjudged best (Yellow & Red groups) totalling maximum **30** to the ICCW Headquarter is **31st December of the year.**
14. Final selection of the Paintings by ICCW will be intimated in due course.
15. Prize Distribution Ceremony will be intimated in due course.
16. Entry Fee: To be determined by State/UT Council (ICCW need to be apprised).
17. The winners of the ICCW Painting Competition will be eligible to receive sponsorship on year to year basis till the child attains the age of 18 years or completes Class XII, whichever is earlier during their schooling years. Sponsorship will be given to only those winners whose family income does not exceed Rs. 11,000/- per month.
18. The winner of the competition will receive Medal, Certificate and Cash Prize.

19. **Differently abled Children:**

“Person with disability” means a person suffering from not less than forty percent of any of the following disability as certified by a medical authority :

Intellectual Disability, Visually impaired, Speech/hearing impaired.

- a. Certificate by a Regd. Medical Authority stating atleast 40% disability of the Competitor must be enclosed for visual disability/ Orthopaedically disability or Locomotor disability.
- b. For hearing disability: Minimum 40 % decibel disability.
- c. Mentally retarded (cut off points I.Q. below 70) is to be certified by a clinical psychologist or psychiatrist.

20. **Paintings will be disqualified on the basis of the following:-**

- a) If the size of the Painting is not according to the scheme.
- b) If Subject/Theme does not tally for the group/sub-group mentioned.
- c) Incomplete entries.
- d) If Type of disability (eg. Cerebral Palsy /Multiple disability, Mentally challenged, Visually Impaired & Speech/Hearing Impaired not clearly mentioned on the backside of the paintings/Result Sheet.
- e) If age does not tally according to the group.
- f) If the paintings are not sub-group-wise under differently abled groups
- g) Disability certificate is mandatory for children applying under the category.
